

The Town of Seneca Falls has initiated a SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL SIDEWALK Project in the neighborhoods surrounding Cady Stanton Elementary School. The Safe Routes to School Program is a Federal, State and Local effort to enable and encourage children to walk and bicycle to school, and to make walking and bicycling to school safe and appealing.

The Project is expected to replace approximately 1,200 feet of existing sidewalks along Chapin Street, Garden Street, Spring Street, White Street, and Meadow Street. It will include the installation of new crosswalks, curb ramps, signage and speed-warning assemblies in the appropriate locations. Please note the following project information:

- No right-of-way takings are anticipated.
- No excavation behind the existing sidewalk is anticipated.
- Traffic will be maintained on-site.
- Any trees that may require removal will be identified during preliminary design, and will be replaced with a tree of suitable size and type for the project location.

Sidewalk replacement will include excavation and disposal of the existing sidewalks and the installation of new five foot wide concrete sidewalks along the existing horizontal and vertical alignments. The new sidewalks will tie into existing driveways and private walkways.

The Town of Seneca Falls, along with the NYS Department of Transportation will hold a Public Informational Meeting to discuss the proposed sidewalk replacement Project at 6:30 P.M. on Wednesday, July 20, 2016 in the Town Hall Meeting Room, 81 W. Bayard Street. The purpose of the Meeting is to obtain comments on the proposed project from Individuals, groups, officials and local agencies. This Public Informational Meeting is part of the continuing efforts by the NYS DOT and the Town of Seneca Falls to encourage public input into the development of transportation projects.
