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2020 Guidelines for Camps and Programs during the Covid-19 Pandemic

- 1) All individuals associated with the program will have their body temperatures measured prior to participation. Anyone with a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher will be kindly asked to leave camp for the day and try again the following day. In addition, anyone with symptoms of respiratory issues and general malaise or to have known exposure to a person with Covid-19 shall not participate until cleared by a medical professional.
- 2) All who are at risk for severe illness due to serious underlying medical conditions shall participate only if permitted by a medical professional.
- 3) PPE coverings shall be worn by all leaders, parents, and visitors while in public at program facilities.
- 4) All program leaders shall wear PPE throughout the duration of the program.
- 5) Program participants will be required to bring PPE with them to the program. They will be worn whenever they are inactive but may be removed during athletic activity. Participants may wear PPE throughout the program if they so choose.
- 6) Program groups will be limited to 12 participants per group. Whenever possible, 6 ft. of social distancing will be practiced between the groups as well as within each group.
- 7) Only program leaders will be allowed to attend program sessions. There will be no spectator accommodations at the Community Center. For programs at Kids Territory, spectators may view the program from inside their personal vehicles only and from a parking spot located along California Ave. No other parking areas may be used.
- 8) Program Leaders will observe 6 ft. of social distancing from all participants and other Leaders whenever possible.
- 9) Upon arrival, each participant will be assigned a location, socially distanced at 6 ft., to place his/her personal effects.
- 10) Participants are to be dropped off/picked up at a designated area each day. A program leader will receive each participant prior to entering the play area and direct them to a health/body temperature check station. Once cleared, participant will enter play area and parent/guardian will be free to leave drop off area. Participants will be delivered to their pickup vehicle by a program leader after each session. We ask that participants be delivered no earlier than ten minutes prior to start time and that they be picked up at the program closing time. This will give us ample time to prep and clean the facility in time for the next session (when applicable).
- 11) Participants should bring large water bottle, clearly marked with name, to each session. Fountains will not be available at program sites. Water bottles will be kept in participant's personal effects area.
- 12) To prevent participant sharing, no food or snacks will be allowed on site during program sessions.
- 13) No equipment will be shared during program sessions. Where applicable, participants will be given a ball to bring each day to program and will be theirs throughout. At the end of the program, the ball will be theirs to keep.
- 14) Bathroom breaks will be provided each session...upon completion of the breaks, Community Center Staff will clean and sanitize those bathrooms used.
- 15) Hand sanitizer stations will be made available to all program leaders and participants throughout the program sessions. However, we encourage all participants to bring their own hand sanitizer if possible.
