

The Seneca Falls Town Board held a Special Meeting on Monday, January 9, 2017 in the Town Hall Meeting Room, 81 W. Bayard Street.

Present were Supervisor Gregory Lazzaro; Councilmen Lou Ferrara, Jr., Dave DeLelys, Thomas Ruzicka and Vittorio Porretta. Also present were Patrick Morrell, Attorney for the Town; Stuart Peenstra, Police Chief and a Member of the local media.

Supervisor Lazzaro called the Special Meeting to order at 3:30 P.M. A roll call was taken of Board Members, and all were present; the Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Personnel Issue: A motion was made to promote Beverly Warfel from Senior Account Clerk to Principal Account Clerk, salary to increase from \$23.78 an hour to \$26.61 an hour, by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Dave DeLelys. No questions. Motion carried 5 ayes, 0 nays.

Women's March in Seneca Falls: Chief Peenstra stated they are expecting more people than previously anticipated. They met today, and the new route will be forming on Mynderse Street, and proceed down Fall Street to State Street, down South Park Street to Cayuga Street, and down Cayuga Street to the Presbyterian Church. The Chief said due to the number of attendance they are expecting, they are going to move it from the sidewalk to the street.

A motion was made to make the above changes on the Special Events application of the Women's March in Seneca Falls 2017 to be held on January 21, 2017 by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Dave DeLelys. No questions. Motion carried 5 ayes, 0 nays.

At 3:40 P.M., a motion was made to go into Executive Session regarding Attorney-Client privilege by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Dave DeLelys. No questions. Motion carried 5 ayes, 0 nays.

A motion was made to reconvene the Special Meeting at 4:10 P.M. by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Dave DeLelys. No questions. Motion carried 5 ayes, 0 nays.

Mr. Lazzaro stated there will be no further action taken today.

Being there was no further business, a motion was made to adjourn the Meeting by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Tom Ruzicka. No questions. Motion carried 5 ayes, 0 nays.
