The Seneca Falls Town Board held a regular monthly Meeting on Tuesday, February 3, 2015 in the Town Hall Meeting Room, 81 W. Bayard Street.

Present were Deputy Supervisor Emil Bove; Councilmen Chad Sanderson, David DeLelys and Duane Moore. Also present were Patrick Morrell, Attorney for the Town; James Spina, Commissioner of Parks & Recreation; Stuart Peenstra, Police Chief; Donald Collins, Assessor; Donald Wood, Highway Superintendent; Jeff Rowe of Barton & Loguidice and a Member of the local Media.

Deputy Supervisor Bove called the regular monthly Meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. A roll call was taken of Board Members and Supervisor Earle was absent from the Meeting; the Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Mary White – Classic Car Show: Mary White stated that she and her husband Scott will be chairing the Classic Car Show Event which will be held on Sunday, July 26, 2015 Downtown Seneca Falls. This year, they will be having a Flea Market and Craft Show in People's Park, and downtown businesses will be open from 10 AM to 3 PM. Mrs. White stated in the past, the Town has given them a donation toward the Show, and this year, they are requesting a donation to cover miscellaneous expenses. She noted that she submitted a Budget.

A motion was made to contribute \$500.00 to the 2015 Seneca Falls Classic Car Show as it is a benefit to the Community by Duane Moore and seconded by Dave DeLelys. No questions. Motion carried 4 ayes, 0 nays.

Kay Irland – Seneca Falls Historical Society: Kay Irland stated she is here on behalf of the Seneca Falls Historical Society. She thanked the Board for the prior years' funding, and requested the release of this year's funding in the amount of \$7,000.00. She said the funding affords the Society to maintain the education program benefitting not only Seneca Falls Students, but also Geneva, Romulus, Waterloo, South Seneca and Port Byron; last year, they saw 1200 Students Taking Tea. Ms. Irland mentioned some of the programs offered at the Historical Society, such as Taking Tea, Colonial Days and Lawn Days.
