

The Seneca Falls Town Board held a Special Meeting on Thursday, February 23, 2017 in the Town Hall Meeting Room, 130 Ovid Street.

Present were Supervisor Gregory Lazzaro, Councilmen Lou Ferrara, Jr., David DeLelys, Thomas Ruzicka and Vittorio Porretta. Also present was Patrick Morrell, Attorney for the Town.

Supervisor Lazzaro called the Meeting to order at 4:00 P.M. A roll call of Board Members was taken and all were present; the Pledge of Allegiance followed.

At 4:02 P.M., a motion was made to go into Executive Session regarding Attorney/Client privileged information by Gregory Lazzaro and seconded by Lou Ferrara. No questions. Motion carried 5 ayes, 0 nays.

A motion was made to reconvene the Special Meeting at 4:15 P.M. by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Lou Ferrara. No questions. Motion carried 5 ayes, 0 nays.

Mr. Lazzaro read the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Seneca Falls believes that it would be advantageous to the Town to rescind Local Law #3 – 2016, known as the Town of Seneca Falls Waste Disposal Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that proposed Local Law No 2 of the year 2017 entitled “Local Law Rescinding Local Law #3 of 2016” be and the same is hereby introduced before the Town Board of the Town of Seneca Falls, New York; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of the aforesaid proposed local law be laid upon the desks of each Member of the Town Board; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board will hold a Public Hearing on said proposed Local Law at the Town Offices, 130 Ovid Street, Seneca Falls, New York at 4:00 P.M. on March 14, 2017; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Clerk publish or cause to be published a notice of said Public Hearing in the official newspaper of the Town at least ten (10) days prior thereto.

Upon adoption of the forgoing provision, the Clerk distributed copies of the aforesaid Local Law to each Member of the Town Board.

A motion was made to adopt the above Resolution introducing proposed Local Law #2 - 2017 and providing for Public Hearing by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Lou Ferrara. No questions. Motion carried 3 ayes, 2 nays; Councilmen DeLelys and Porretta with the dissenting votes.

Being there was no further business, a motion was made to adjourn the Meeting by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Lou Ferrara. No questions. Motion carried 5 ayes, 0 nays.

Meeting adjourned at 4:22 P.M.
