

The Seneca Falls Town Board held a Special Meeting on Thursday, May 16, 2019 in the Town Hall Meeting Room, 130 Ovid Street.

Present were Supervisor Gregory Lazzaro; Councilmen David DeLelys, Douglas Avery and Vittorio Porretta.

Supervisor Lazzaro called the Special Meeting to order at 3:30 P.M. A roll call of Board Members was taken and Councilman Ferrara was absent from the Meeting; the Pledge of Allegiance followed.

At 3:31 P.M., a motion was made to go into Executive Session to interview Applicants for the position of Member of Planning Board by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Dave DeLelys. No questions. Motion carried 4 ayes, 0 nays.

A motion was made to reconvene the Special Meeting at 3:55 P.M. by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Doug Avery. No questions. Motion carried 4 ayes, 0 nays.

Award Bid – Route 89 Watermain Replacement: Mr. Tullo stated Dave Rauscher's bid was the only bid, and it is a very reasonable bid - there will still be some other cost but not to Mr. Rauscher. He noted \$117,000 was put in the Budget which includes engineering fees and restoration of property – it's going to be under budget. Mr. Tullo said it will take at least three weeks to get the material, and it will take time to get the State permits for the road.

A motion was made to accept the bid of D.C. Rauscher, Inc. in the amount of \$59,348.75 by Dave DeLelys and seconded by Doug Avery. No questions. Motion carried 4 ayes, 0 nays.

Highway: A motion was made to return Ernest Tillman back to his Laborer position due to the return of Donovan Stillwell who was out on disability by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Doug Avery. No questions. Motion carried 4 ayes, 0 nays.

Discussion followed relative to extending sewer lines and if it is required that property owners have to hook into the sewer line. The Town Clerk mentioned that it is in the Code that property owners have to hook into the sewer line; Mr. DeLelys said it is in the Code. After further discussion regarding the petition of property owners on Gravel Road, Mr. DeLelys suggested that at the June Meeting, the Board authorizes Barton & Loguidice to send letters to all the property owners on Gravel Road to see how many are interested in extending the sewer line.

Donation of American Flags: A motion was made to accept the donation of 50 American Flags from del Lago Resort and Casino by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Doug Avery.

Mr. Lazzaro stated del Lago had an access of flags for a give-away, and now they are offering them to municipalities. Mr. Avery stated the intent was to give them away - they will be available here and at the Community Center. Brief discussion followed.

The above motion made by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Doug Avery to accept the donation of 50 American Flags from del Lago Resort and Casino was carried 4 ayes, 0 nays.

Restoration Issues –Safe Routes to School Project: Mr. Avery stated he met with Luke Morenus and two homeowners who expressed concern about the quality of the restoration on Spring Street. He said the amount of topsoil and the quality of the topsoil is not what it is suppose to be. There are a lot of stones and pieces of asphalt just barely under the surface, and there is suppose to be 3" of topsoil; in some places, there is maybe ½". Mr. Avery stated someone on White Street had similar concerns. He noted there were other things that were addressed; homeowners were pleased with the responses that got.

Being there was no further business, a motion was made to adjourn the Meeting by Greg Lazzaro and seconded by Dave DeLelys. No questions. Motion carried 4 ayes, 0 nays.

Meeting adjourned at 4:20 P.M.
