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1. Thank you to the It's A Wonderful Life Museum for organizing Antonio Varacalli Day on April 12 and hosting relatives of Antonio and Ruth Dunham.
2. Thank you to the It's A Wonderful Life Committee for hosting Antonio Varacalli Day on April 23 and their Celebration of Heroes. Congratulations to the family of David DeLelys on accepting the posthumous 2022 Antonio Varacalli Award on behalf of Dave.
3. Request for Proposals (RFP) will be going out for the Water Meter Replacement project to secure a contractor.
4. Work on Veteran's Bridge is anticipated this summer. The scope of work includes repairs to the expansion joints on the north and south sides of the bridge with bridge closures for an undetermined number of days. The Town has saved about \$110,000.00 for this project to date, but will most likely be more.
5. Cayuga Nation has applied for a Special Use Permit for 126 E. Bayard Street. Additionally, they have also submitted plans and permit applications for their new grow facility on Ovid Street.
6. The Town is collaborating with the County on the implementation of the Low-Income Household Water Assistance Program through Seneca County's Department of Human Services (315-539-1830) and the Office of the Aging (315-539-1766). Please contact these agencies to learn more about the qualifications of the program. Information is also available on the Town's website.
7. The Town was awarded a \$1.7 million grant from the Omnibus Legislation for the Equalization Tank Project. The Town will bond the balance at 0% interest. Thank you to Peter Baker from Barton & Loguidice and Rhonda Destino and Matt Horn from the MRB Group and to Senator Gillibrand, Senator Schumer and Congressman Reed.
8. Property Assessment Re-evaluation Update: A Public Informational Meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 18, at 6:30 PM at the Seneca Falls Community Center to provide information to residents and businesses about the process of the property re-evaluation project.
