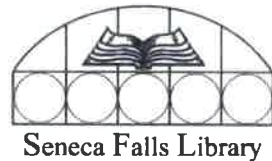

OFFERED TO CHILDREN ENTERING GRADES 1-6 IN SEPT. 2022

DIRECTOR: Katie Smith is returning for her 3rd year as the Director of our program. Katie has her Masters in Early Childhood Education & Special Education, grades 1-6. Katie is the leader of the Childcare program for the Romulus School District. She has also worked in the community with Girl Scouts for over 9 years.

Learn to Swim 2022

Vince's Park will offer 1 session of swim instruction this summer for a 2-week period. This session will consist of 8 days over 2 weeks, Monday through Thursday. There are no classes on weekends or Fridays unless severe weather (2x) causes a make-up date to complete course work. Each session will run 45 minutes long. Levels of instruction will range from Toddler through Advanced. Parents are not required to attend classes with children, the staff at Vince's Park requests that if you prefer to stay, that you do not sit on the pool deck. This allows for easier instruction from our staff.

Class size is limited on a first received basis and payment is required to register. If a class fills a waiting list will be taken. Every effort is made to accommodate as many children as possible without corrupting the integrity of the program. Vince's Park program philosophy is simple: quality over quantity.

Levels of Instruction:

Preschool Aquatics: Basic Skills include new levels of water adjustment, underwater exploration and personal safety without parents. This is a basic, FUN introduction to water. Ages 4 & 5

Level 1: To begin developing positive attitudes, good swimming habits and safe practices in and around the water.

Level 2: To give participants success with fundamental skills, including learning how to float without support and to recover to a vertical position.

Level 3: To build on the skills in Level 2 by providing additional guided practice in deeper water.

Level 4: To develop participants' confidence in the strokes learned in Level 3 and to improve other aquatic skills.

Level 5: Skills include stroke proficiency, turns, personal safety and rescue.

Level 6: Personal Safety & Rescue, Fitness Swimmer, Diving Refinement.

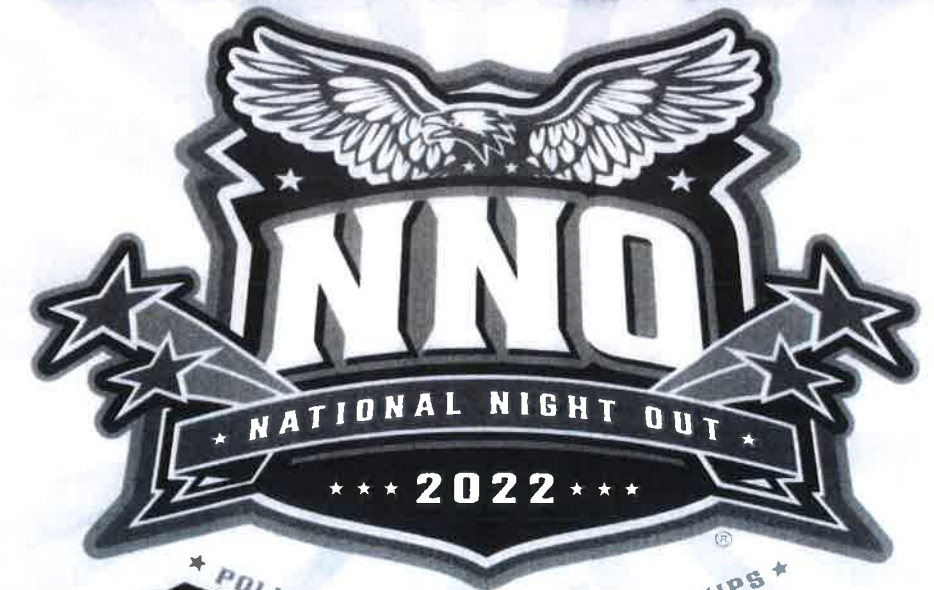

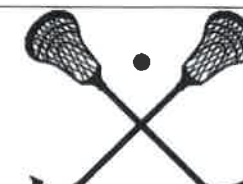
